The Pool Is Now Open!



As are the locker rooms, jacuzzi and sauna

Though most of the clubhouse remains closed, the pool deck, sauna and locker rooms can now be used.

All other areas of the clubhouse remain closed and strictly off limits due to ongoing demolition and removal of damaged drywall, carpet and other materials.

This includes the lobby area, which means the clubhouse front door is *not to be used* (even though you may see work crews entering and exiting through the front door.)

Please do not attempt to access the office – it is a hazardous construction zone.

To access the pool deck and/or locker rooms, please

turn left after crossing the bridge, walk around the clubhouse past the gazebo, then up the stairs onto the patio. Use your fob to enter through either of the two glass doors opening onto the pool deck.



It's imperative that those two doors – and only those two doors – be used. It is the only entry/exit that avoids hazardous materials (such as nail-studded debris) throughout the rest of the clubhouse. *Please do not exit the locker rooms into the clubhouse corridor!*

It will probably be several weeks before the rest of the clubhouse can be used – and even then, it will likely have bare concrete floors and unpainted walls – pending selection of flooring (carpet or laminated wood?), paint colors and any furniture that was damaged beyond repair.
