Wood Chip Volunteers Commit Egregious Error



They did too good a job. Efficiently, safely and with "great camaraderie" – over five weeks they moved an estimated 300 wheelbarrows of wood chips (they lost count at 283 - that was the day Dave brought the beer.) Working two days a week

for five weeks till done.

"In hindsight, I suppose we should all have expected it" says Desmond - one of the barrow operators. "But because we did such a good job, the LSC Chair has now

enlisted us to "relocate" the piles of river rocks currently located in some of our parking areas.

How could we have not seen that coming? And, if she's to be believed, rocks are much heavier than wood chips we're going to need more people!"

More owners are wondering these days – what can we do to reduce costs?

The DeSantis estimate to distribute those same wood chips? \$5,500. Add to that the \$5,000 grant our Landscaping Committee obtained last Spring (for the bioswale behind Sequoia) and you realize they've reduced HOA costs by over \$10,000 so far in 2022. A great example of neighbors working together - to reduce our operational expenses.
